What is a CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture provides a direct connection to locally grown food for the community while also providing a dedicated market for the farmer. Because the CSA member pays for their produce in advance of the growing season, this model provides much-needed working capital for the purchase of seeds, hire staff, make investments in the farm operation and to be able to plan expenditures throughout the growing season.



What we grow.

Kilt farm is growing over 100 varieties of vegetables including unique heirlooms like Petite Gris De Rennes melons, and Romanesco Cauliflower to 3 types of carrots, 4 types of potatoes, kale, chard, lettuce, watermelon and amazing tomatoes. Shares for 2015

Our 2015 season will run for 18 weeks from second week in June to the middle of October. We will have self-service pickups in East Boulder, Downtown Boulder, Denver, Lakewood, Dillon and Steamboat Springs.

- Family Share \$630 feeds 4-6 (\$35 a week)
- Regular Share \$450 feeds 2-4 (\$25 a week)
- Bi-Weekly Share \$330 – a Family Sized Share every-other week - 9 weeks
- Fruit Shares \$230, 11 weeks, over 75lbs of organically grown Colorado fruit from Ela Family Farm.
