WHAT IS A CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) provides a direct connection to locally grown food for the community while also providing a dedicated market for the farmer. CSA Members pay for their produce in advance of the growing season, which provides much-needed working capital for the farm to purchase seeds, hire labor, and make investments in the farm operation.

WHAT WE GROW

Kilt Farm is growing over 100 varieties of vegetables from unique heirloom melons, to three varieties colors of carrots, four types of potatoes, kale, chard and of course, amazing tomatoes. The entire list of what we grow can be found on our website.

PICKUP LOCATIONS

This year we are expanding and will be offering shares through our self-service pick up locations around Boulder County, Denver, Lakewood, Summit County and Steamboat Springs.



KILT FARM SHARES

Our season will run for 18 weeks from mid-June to Mid-October.

Family Share \$630

Feeds 4-6, \$35 a week.

Regular Share \$450

Feeds 2-4, \$25 a week

Bi-Weekly Share \$330

Family Share every-other week through the CSA Season.

Fruit Shares \$230

75 pounds of organically grown Colorado Fruit produced by Ela Family Farm over 11 weeks starting in late-July.
